


Plotly Example

```
library(reticulate)

python <- "~/.virtualenvs/python-3.7.7-venv/bin/python"
if (file.exists(python))
  use_python(python, required = TRUE)
```

plotly figures should be rendered on `.show()`

```
import plotly.express as px
fig = px.scatter(x=[0, 1, 2, 3, 4], y=[0, 1, 4, 9, 16])
fig.show()
```



plotly figures should be implicitly rendered on print

```
import plotly.express as px
fig = px.scatter(x=[0, 1, 2, 3, 4], y=[0, 1, 4, 9, 16])
fig
```
