

Cali is located in the Valle del Cauca departament, 100 kilometers from the Pacific port of Buenaventura. It is the second most important city in Colombia after Bogotá. Cali has one of the fastest growing economies in the country and is also the principal urban, cultural, economic, and industrial center of southwestern Colombia.

The city is a salsa music mecca, which has led to the development of the cultural industry sector. This has in turn contributed to the city's service-oriented economy. Cali offers a region full of nature, adventure, and entertainment. It is an ideal place to have a fully South American experience.

Cali is 1070 m above sea level, enjoying warm weather (28-30° C/82-86° F) nearly year round because of its location in a tropical region of the country
